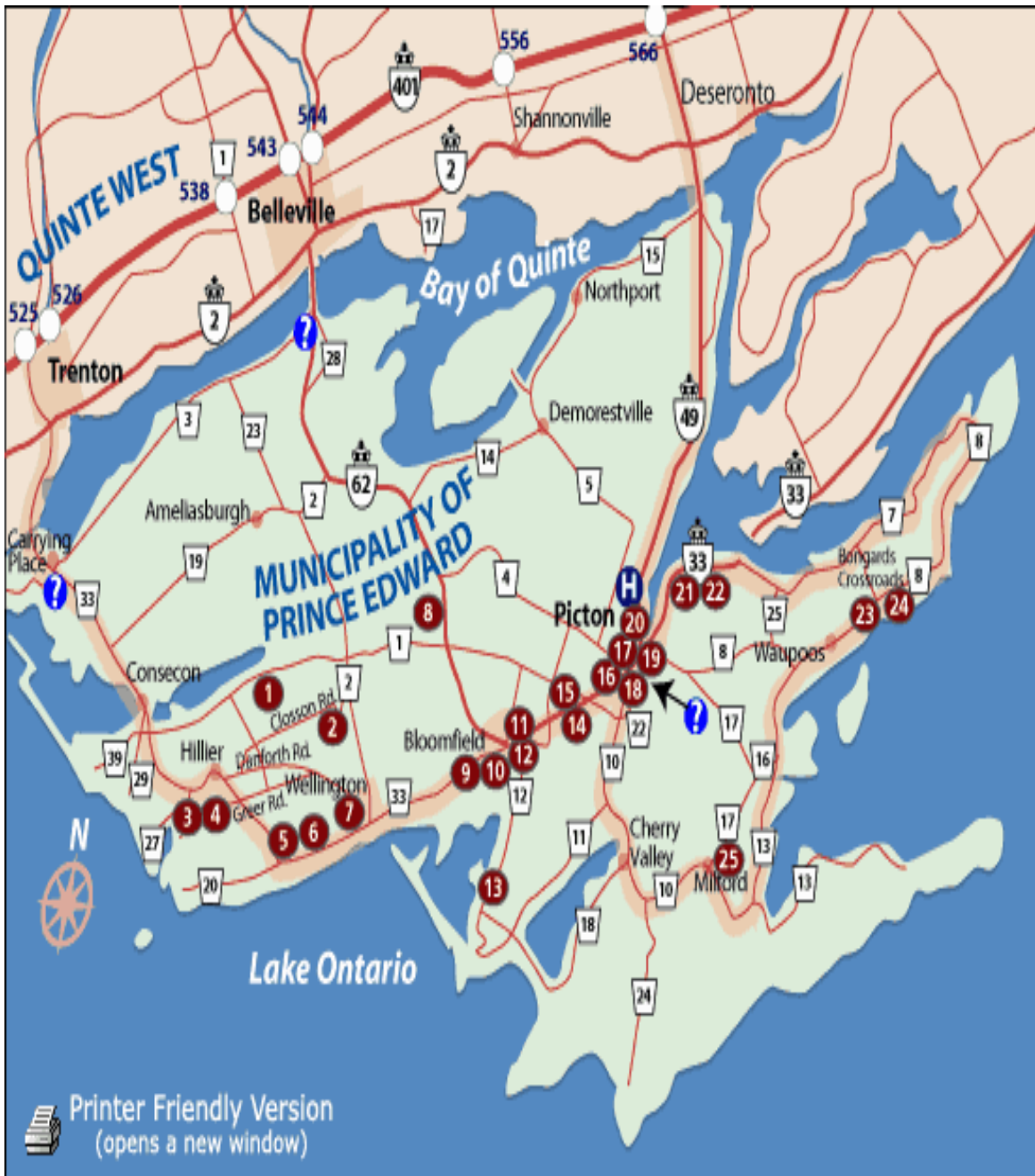

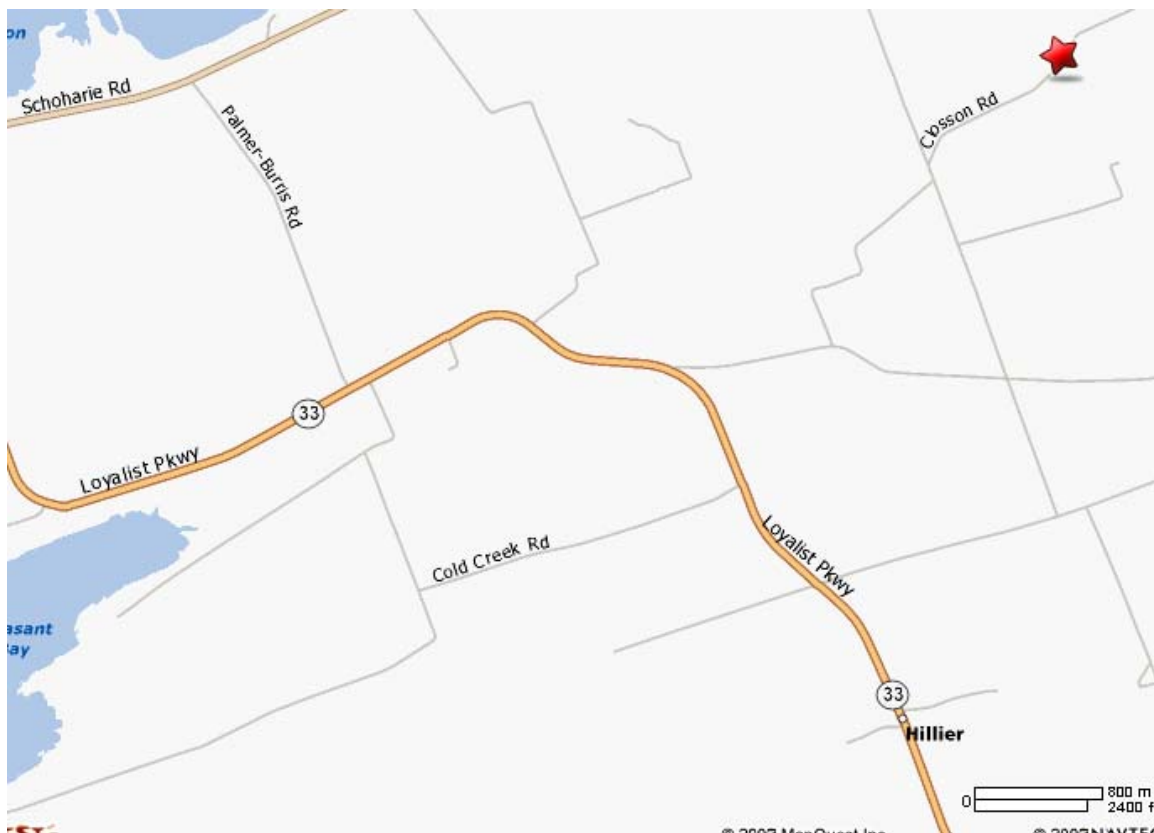
## The Grange of Prince Edward Vineyards & Estate Winery

## **2** Closson Chase Vineyard

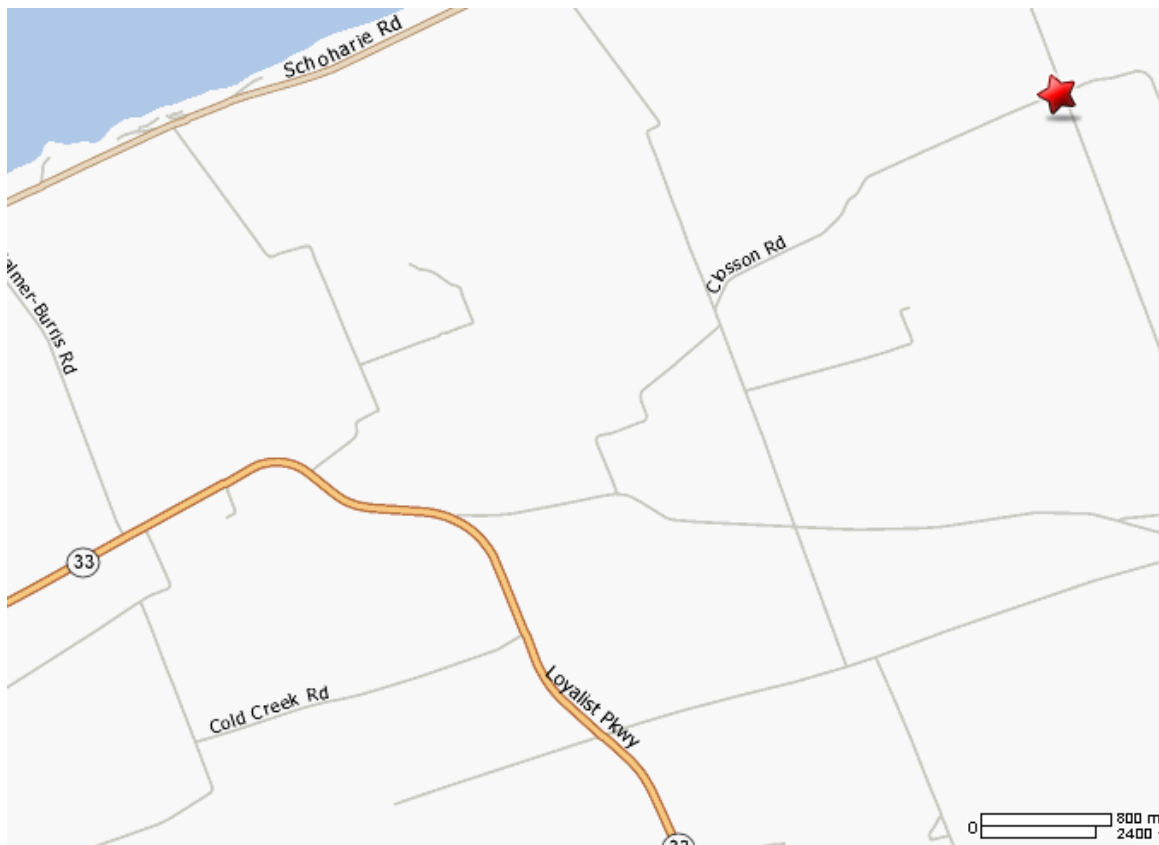

### 3 Rosehall Run Vineyards

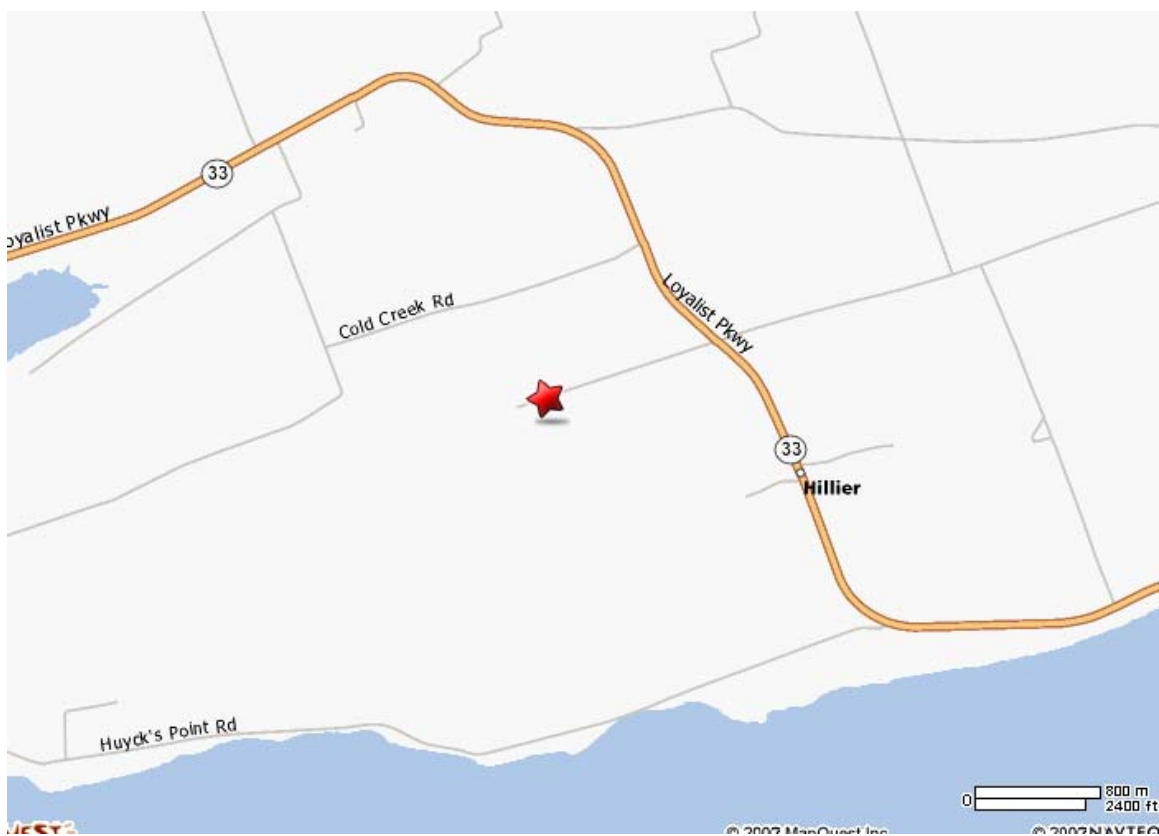

## Carmela Estates Winery

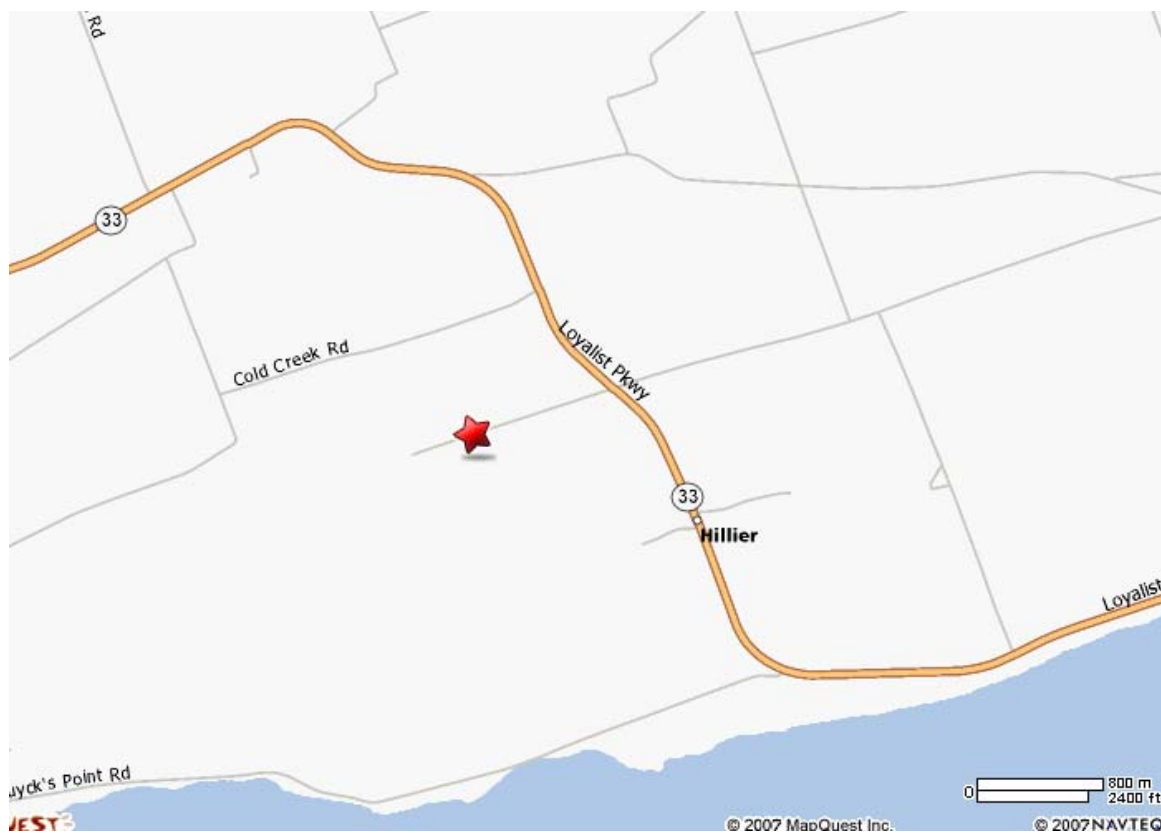

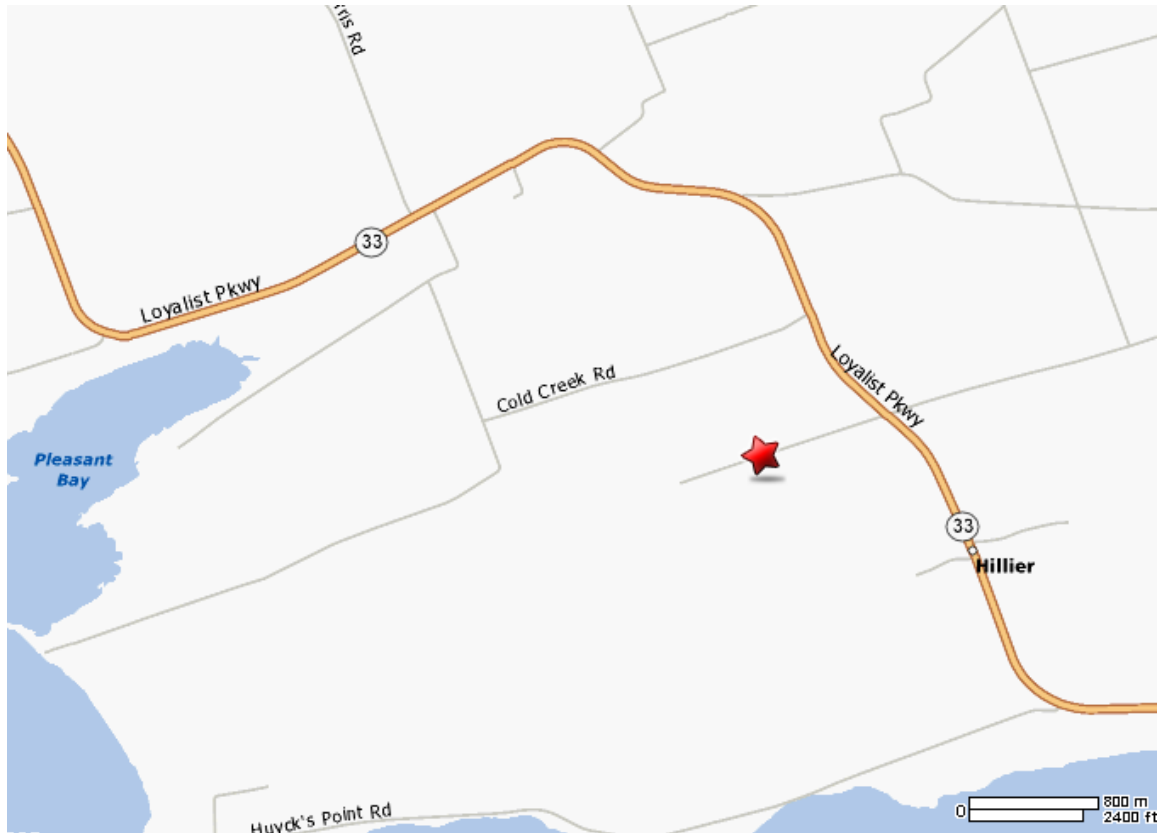

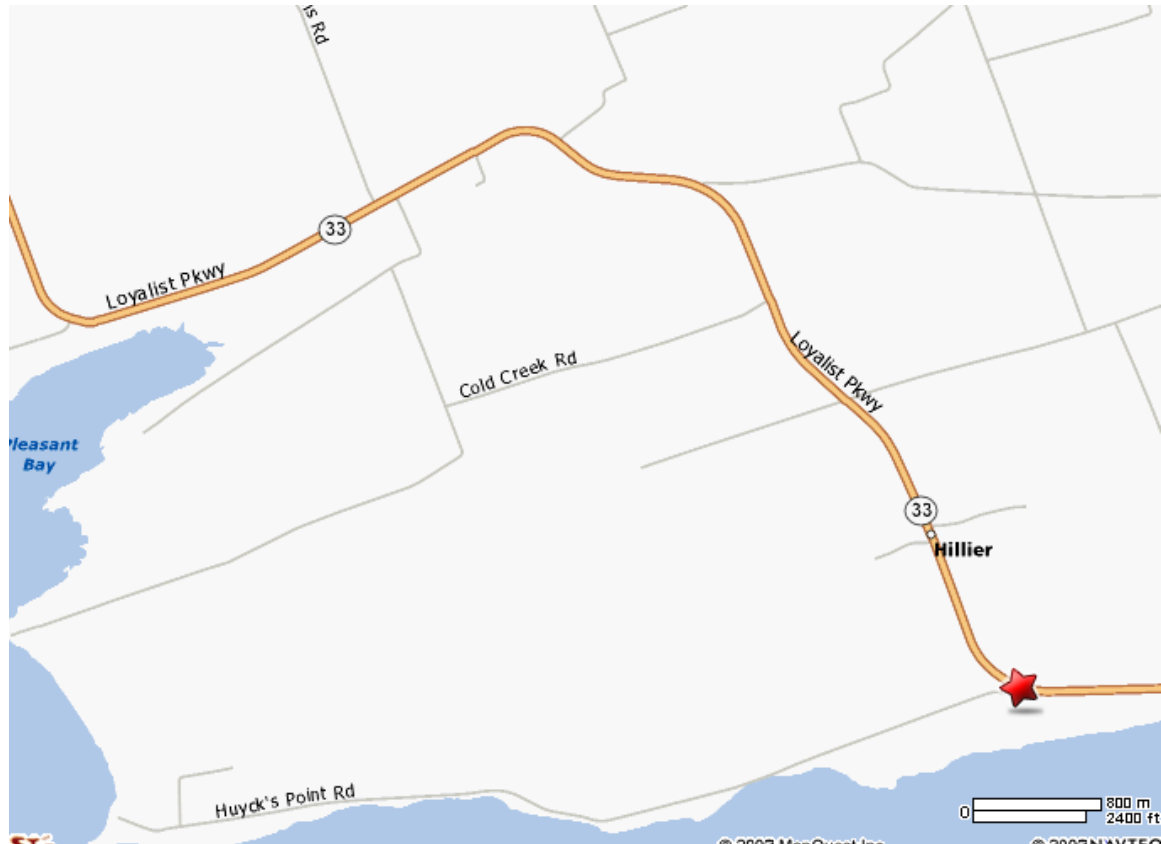

## 6 By Chadsey's Cairns

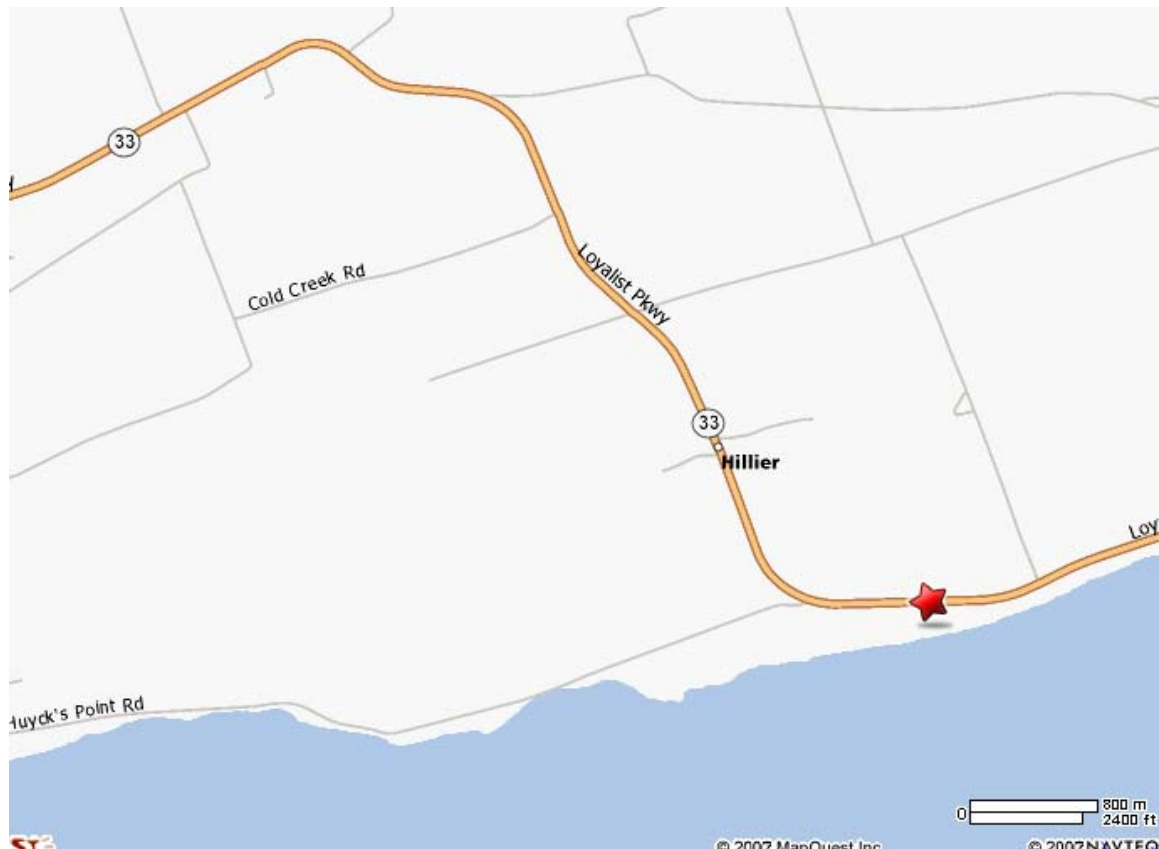
Cool climate grape growing produces whites that are delicate, or nervy reds that range from lighthearted to serious – but in the County you first need to survive the winter. Committed to producing authentic County wines, owners Vida and Richard completely bury their 20 acres of vines grown on an exclusive ridge of ancient beach soil. The winery is located in a glorious and storied setting where an early settler built stone cairns so that he could always find his way home. The wine shop and winery are housed in a cluster of historic buildings overlooking Lake Ontario. Open daily in the summer, 11am to 6pm. Open weekends spring and fall.

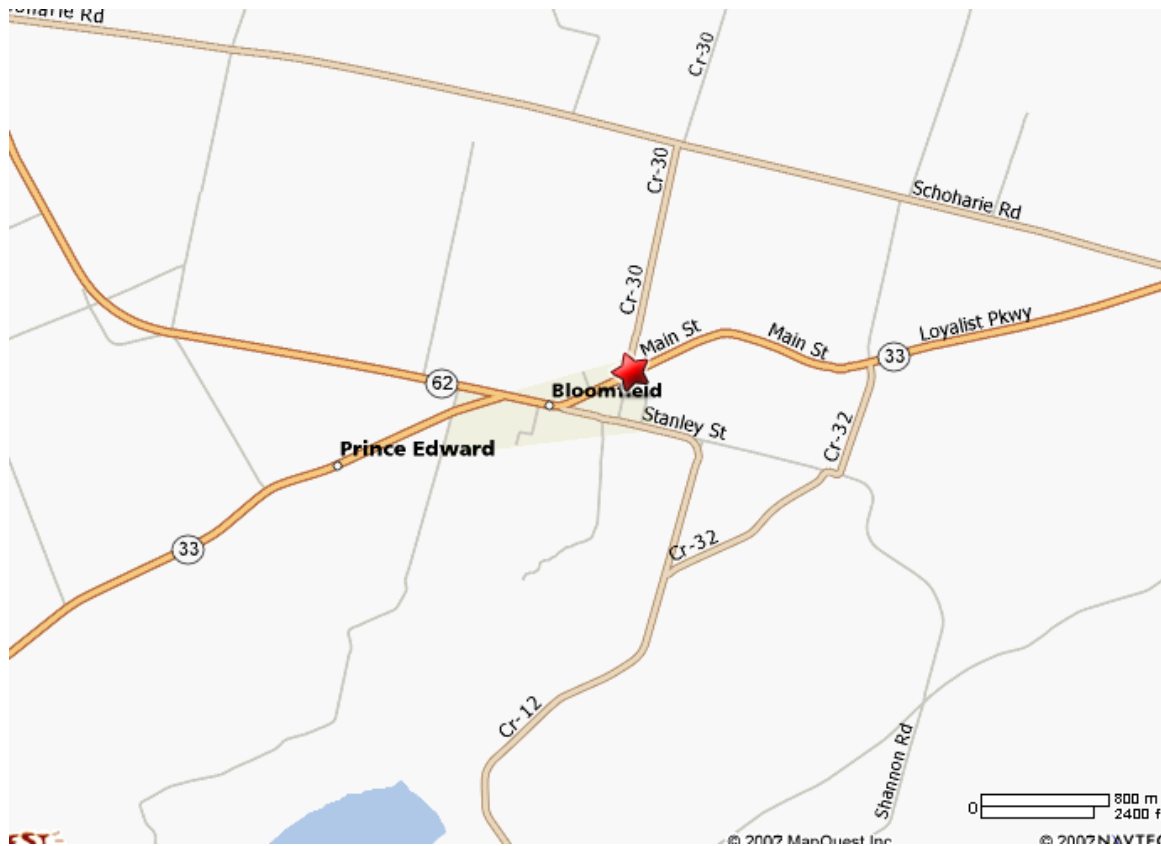
## Thirty Three Vines

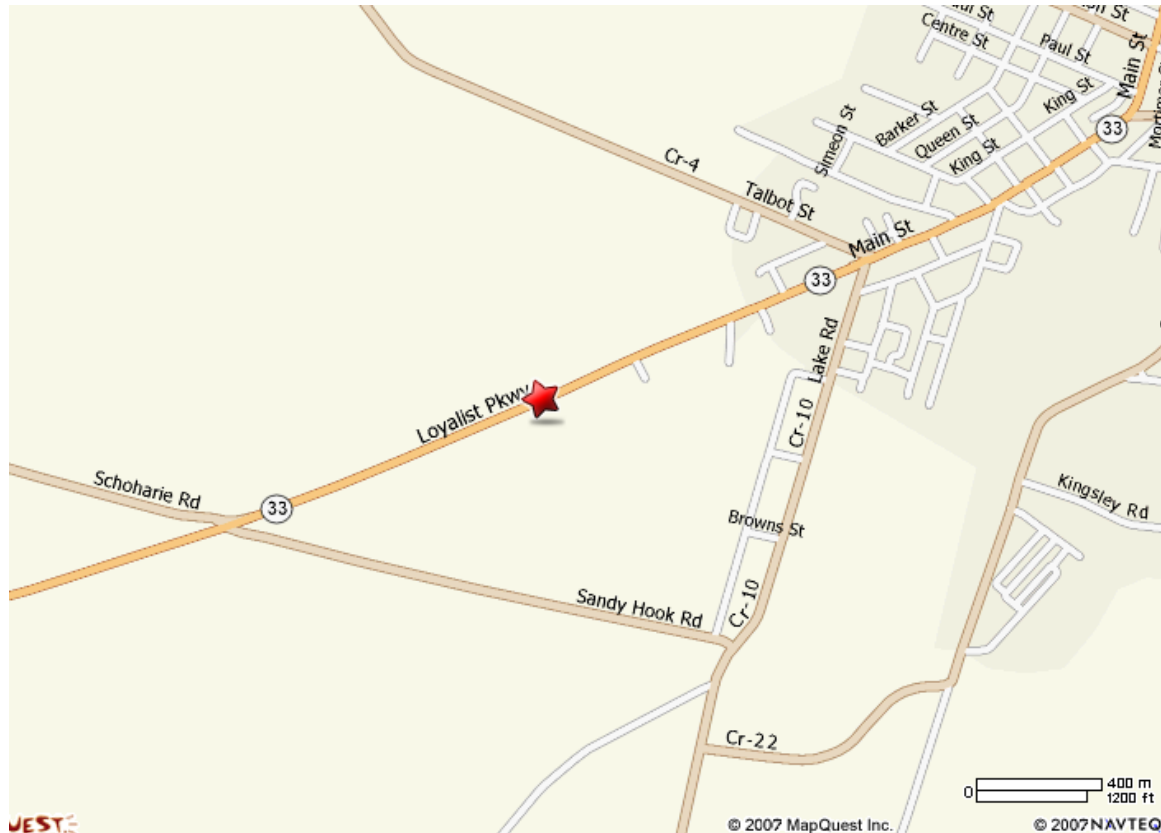
## 16 Black Prince Winery

## 23 Waupoos Estates Winery

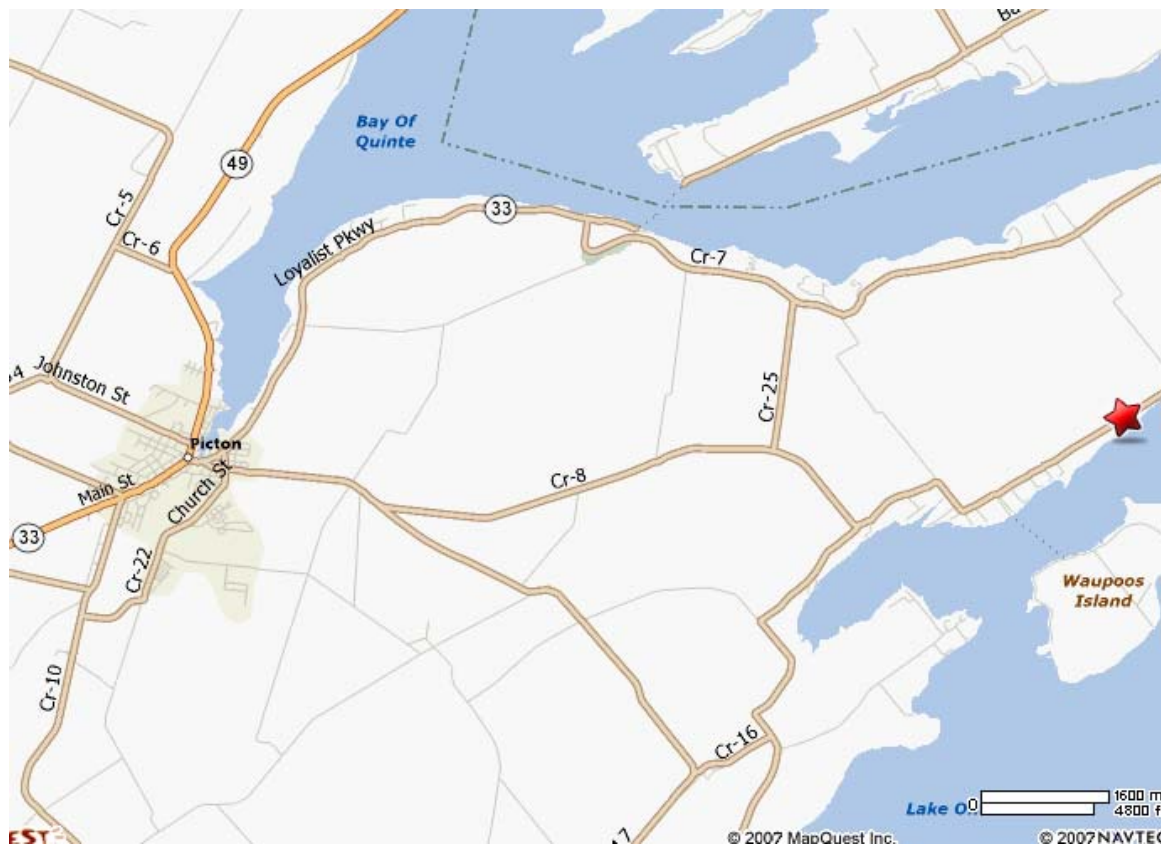
